Evacuation Protocol

- There is possible danger INSIDE the school. Examples can include; fire, chemical spill, gas leak, etc.
- Students will be escorted by staff to a safe location away from the school.
- If required, students will be transported to predetermined evacuation centres. Students will be released using the division’s Student Release procedures.
- No one will re-enter the school until the Incident Commander issues the ALL CLEAR.

How will parents be notified if the Evacuation protocol is initiated?

Parents may not always be notified immediately when the Evacuation protocol is initiated. If the incident requires students to remain away from the school for a period of time, parents will be notified. Should students be transported to another location, a notification with instructions will be sent to parents using the division’s School Messenger notification system. Further updates will also be posted on the division website and social media accounts.
