Lock-Down Protocol

- A Lock-Down protocol is initiated when there is an immediate **THREAT of VIOLENCE** to students and staff **INSIDE** the building.
- The main objective of a Lock-Down is to protect the maximum number of people by getting behind **LOCKED DOORS**.
- In a Lock-Down situation, students and staff will be locked in secure areas and the school will **NOT** operate as normal. **No one will be allowed in or out of the school.**
- The Lock-Down will not end until the Incident Commander on-site issues the **ALL CLEAR** and doors are unlocked by the Incident Commander or police.

How will parents be notified if a Lock Down occurs?

It may not always be possible to send out information until after the incident has ended. Once it is safe to do so, a message via phone, text and email will be sent to all guardians using the division's School Messenger system. Details regarding the incident, student pick up and any additional details will be included in the message.
